Congratulations to ou May 2014 Alumnus of the Month Joseph Fairfield '99

Lieutenant Colonel Joseph Fairfield is a leader in his profession, serving as an active duty judge advocate in the U.S. Army since November of 1999. Since 9/11 he has served over 5

months deployed to both Afghanistan and Iraq. LTC Fairfield is currently deployed to Afghanistan, serving a 12 month deployme which ends this June. He is the Staff Judge Advocate for the Special Operations Joint Command-Afghanistan (SOJTF-A) an Senior Legal Advisor for the NATO Special Operations Component Command-Afghanistan (NSOCC-A). SOJTF-A/NSOCC-A is a division-level headquarters and is commanded by a two-star general and encompasses all in-country NATO special operations forces and assets, close to 13,000 special operators, staff, and support from over 25 different nations. As t senior legal advisor, LTC Fairfield oversees over 20 attorneys from three different nations and 15 legal support personnel. He is responsible for providing advice to the command and staff regarding the rules of engagement, international law, administrativ law, fiscal law, contract law, and military justice.
